CHICAGO HOSTS FIRST HIDDEN HEROES IMPACT FORUM



The Elizabeth Dole Foundation, in conjunction with the city of Chicago, hosted a first-ever Hidden Heroes Impact Forum on May 29. Led by Illinois Dole Caregiver Fellow Theresa Coomer, the forum aimed to connect caregivers, discuss the military and veteran caregiver experience, and highlight local resources available to caregivers and their families. The forum featured a Caregiver Experience Panel where caregivers discussed their experiences and a Mental Health Professional Panel where therapists and VA Caregiver Program Coordinators discussed the necessary support military and veteran caregivers need as they navigate their role.

This successful program was part of a multi-day veteransfocused effort by the City of Chicago, which included a 17-mile Ruck March to raise awareness for veteran suicide and Memorial Day observances.

HIDDEN HEROES DAY IN NEWPORT

Rhode Island Dole Caregiver Fellow Consuelo Jessop met with Newport Mayor Jeanne-Marie Napolitano after the mayor declared "Hidden Heroes Day" in Newport, RI.
